HOW TO APPLY

- **Application for Admission**

Complete an application for admission. It is highly recommended that you apply online at www.spcs.neu.edu. Applications are also available at each College of Professional Studies campus location.

- **Academic Transcripts**

Submit proof of high school completion (high school transcripts, GED, or equivalent), as well as any official transcripts from colleges or universities you have attended or are currently attending.*

* Additional documents may be required for specific programs.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:

In addition to the above requirements, provide:

- All foreign educational documents. Official English translations will be required.
- Completed Declaration and Certification of Finances
- Original supporting financial documents

Please note: To allow time for the visa application process, it is highly recommended that the application for admission to the school be submitted and complete at least 6 weeks prior to the anticipated start term. Any applications received less than 6 weeks prior to the start term may affect a timely issuance of the proper visa for enrollment with valid immigrations status. This may then delay the enrollment term.
